Standards for Enrollment in AA and Flex

Following are the rules for enrollment in the AA and Flex programs at College View High School. These programs are designed to help students complete their high school education. Completion of these programs requires focus and commitment from participants. Distracting behavior not only limits your ability to complete the requirements, it also limits your fellow classmates. Failure to follow these rules can and will result in removal from the program. These programs are a privilege and will be treated as such.

- ID's worn at all times
- No cell phones: Cell phones are NOT allowed during class at any time. If you must use a phone, request permission to go to the front office.
- No streaming of music, videos or other "entertainment" during instructional time.
- No sitting or laying on the floor.
- No napping during instructional time.
- Students must make measurable progress toward the completion of their coursework.
- Completion deadlines are determined by the number of classes a student needs for graduation completion.
- Students must sit near the facilitator with their computer screen visible when taking all exams. This includes prescriptive exams.
- Talking to fellow students during instructional time is not allowed. Please raise your hand and ask for help from the facilitator as needed.
- After 30 minutes of instructional time, students will have the option to take a "brain break" for up to 15 minutes. Students may listen to music on their computers at this time, put their heads down on the desk to take a brief nap, read, or work on appropriate hobbies. Facilitators may come up with other "brain break" activities as appropriate. Phones will NOT be allowed.
- Attendance is mandatory--Truancy will be filled after 10 unexcused absences.
