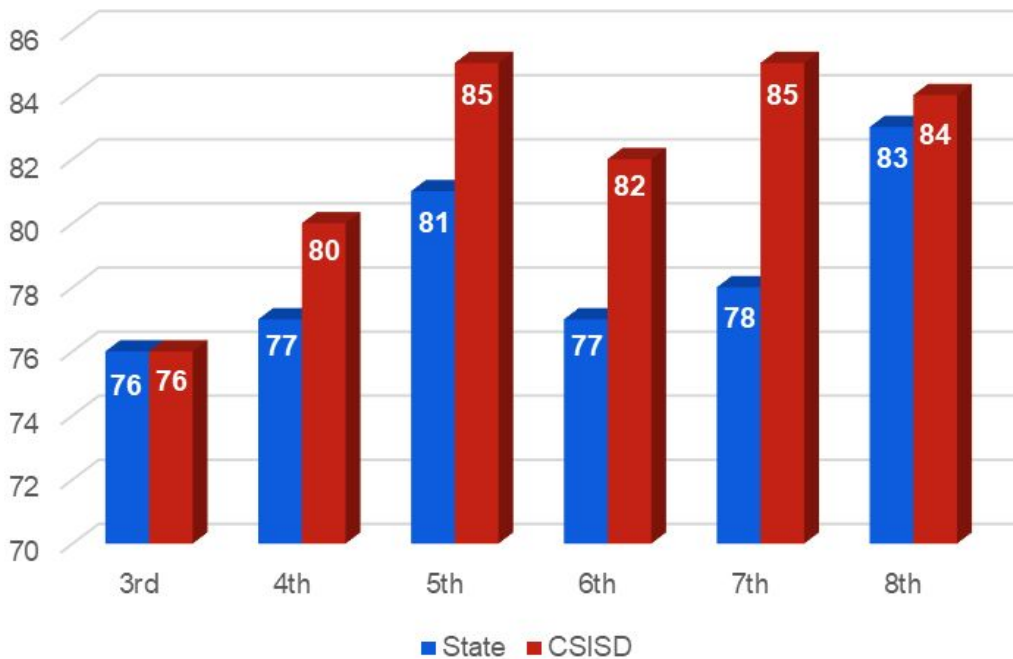

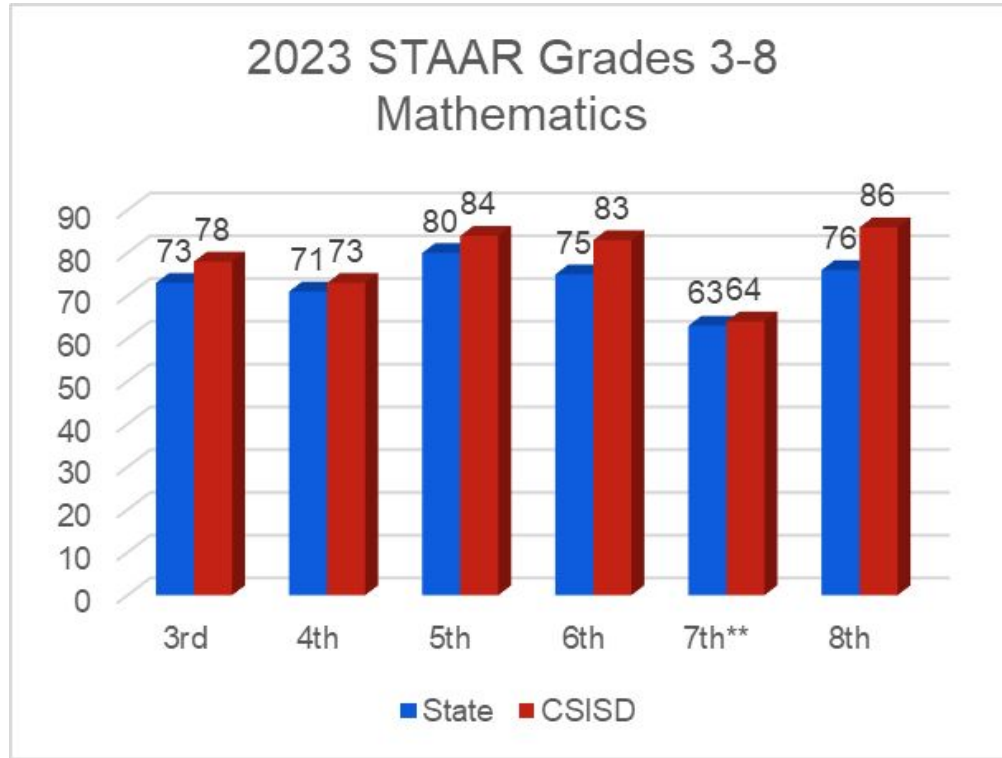
Approaches Grade Level

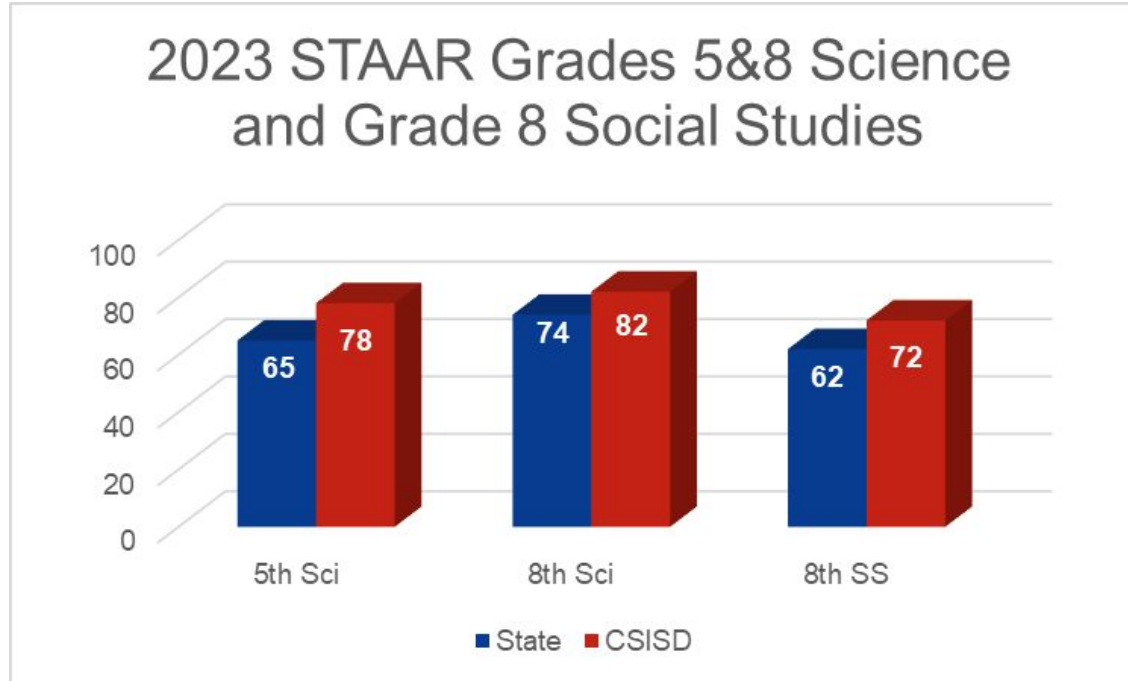


59% of 7th grade students participated in the grade 7 math STAAR due to advanced math enrollment

65% of 8th grade students took the on-level grade 8 math exam

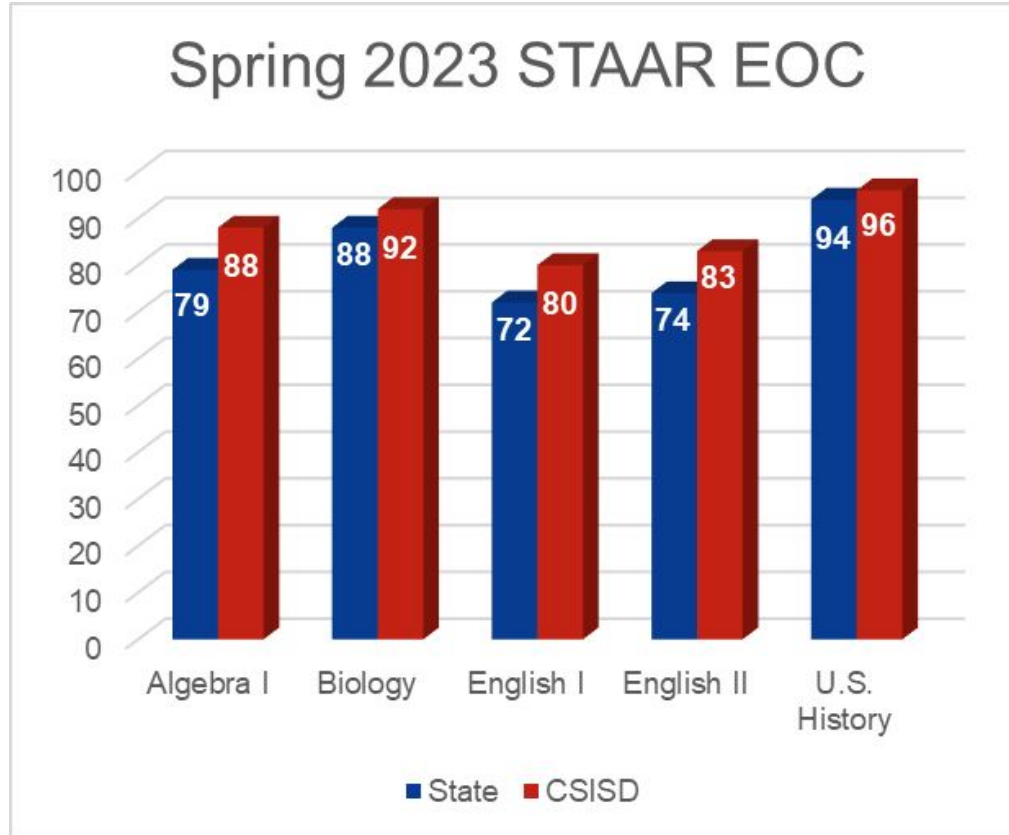

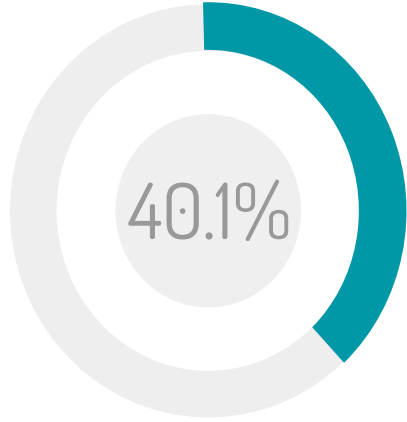

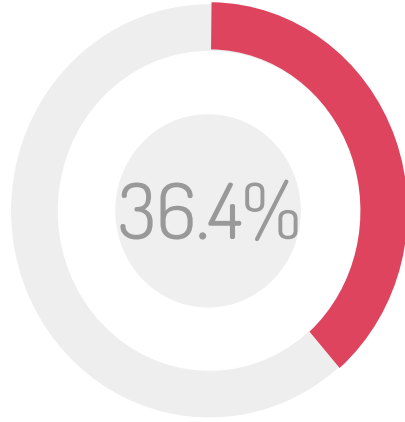

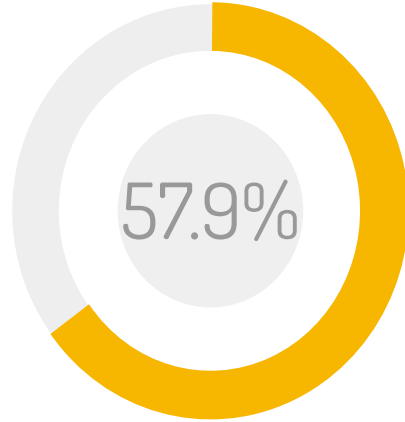

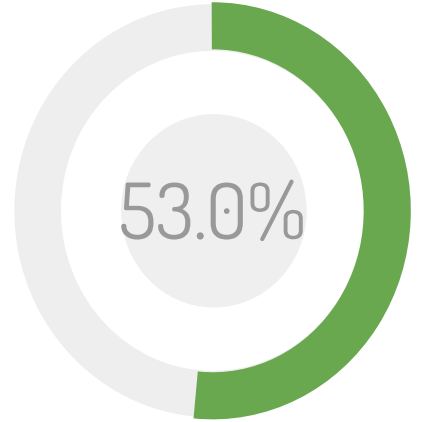

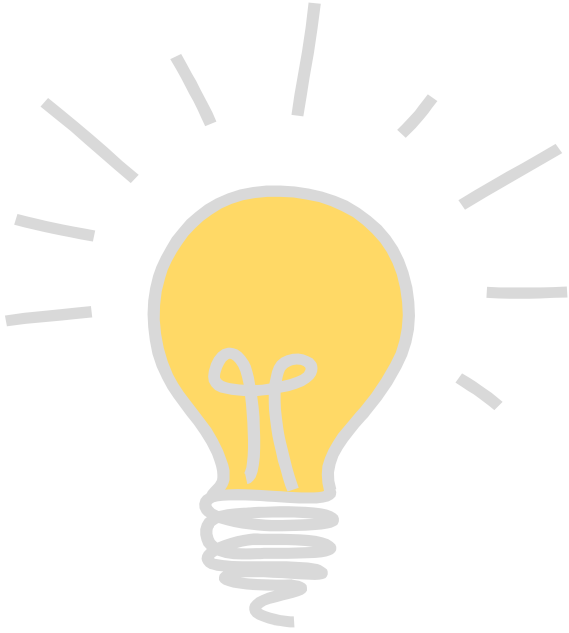

Advanced Placement



Across all subjects, **32%** of 11th & 12th grade students **participated** in AP exams in at least one subject. (*State = 23.0%*)



Participation rates in Social Studies (18.8%) were highest, then Math (17.3%), Science (13.2%) and ELA (11.7%)



CSISD students taking AP exams perform exceptionally well relative to their peers across the state: **79.8% of students met criterion** in all subjects (*state rate = 53.3%*)

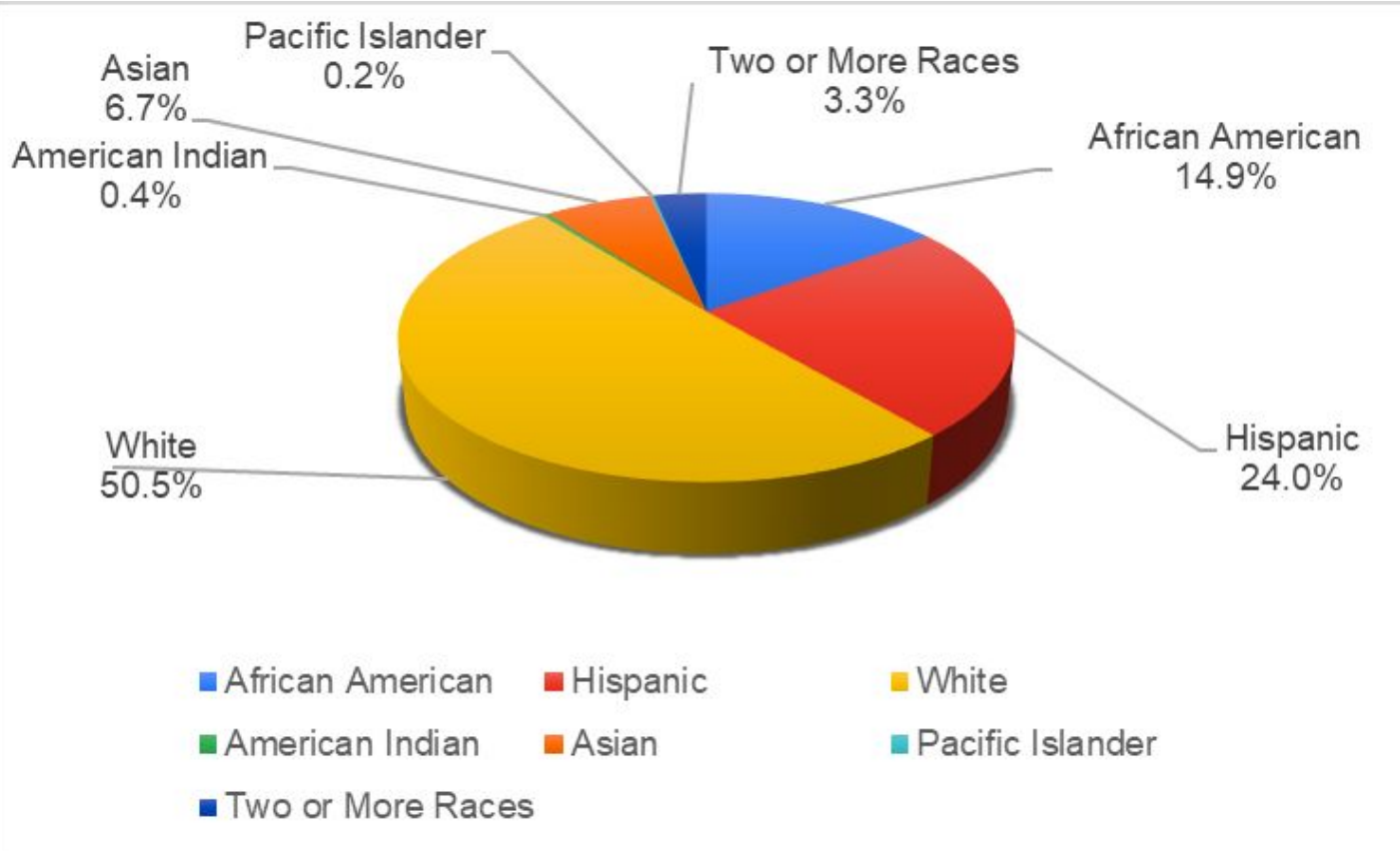

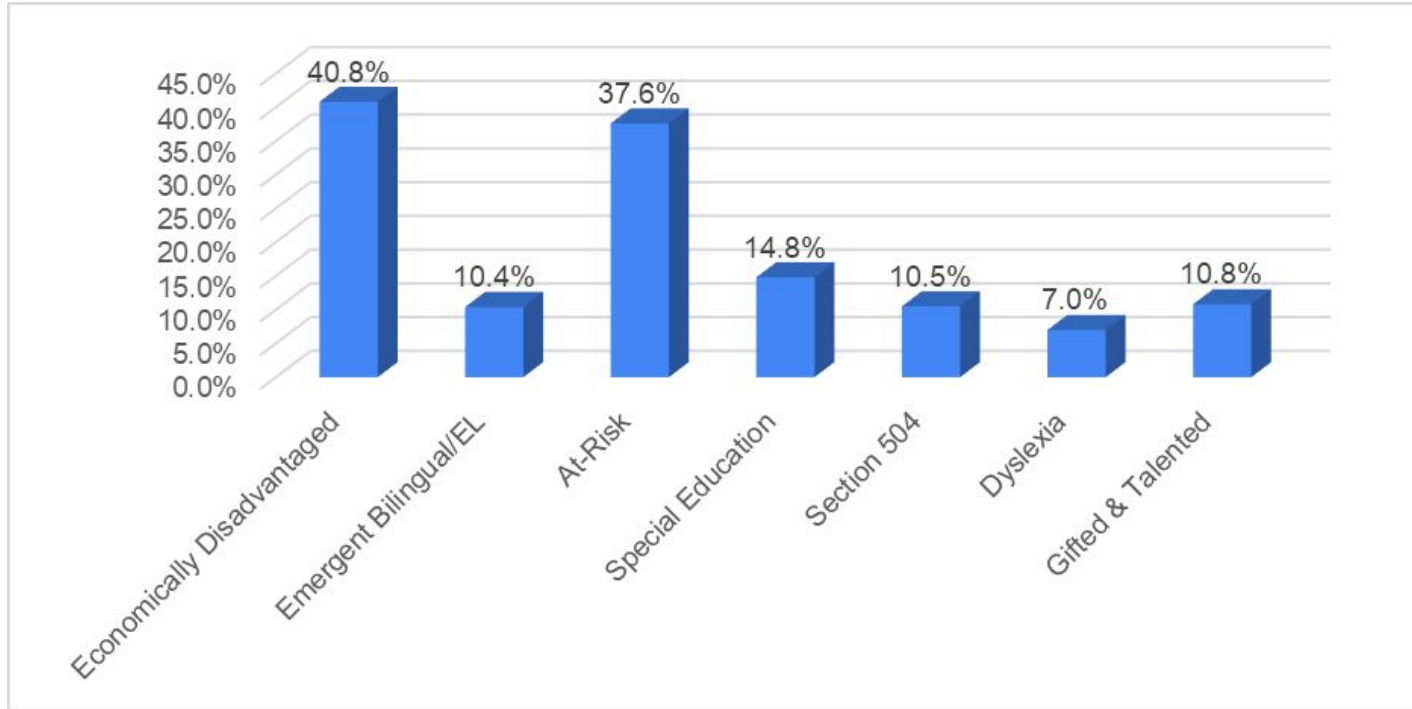

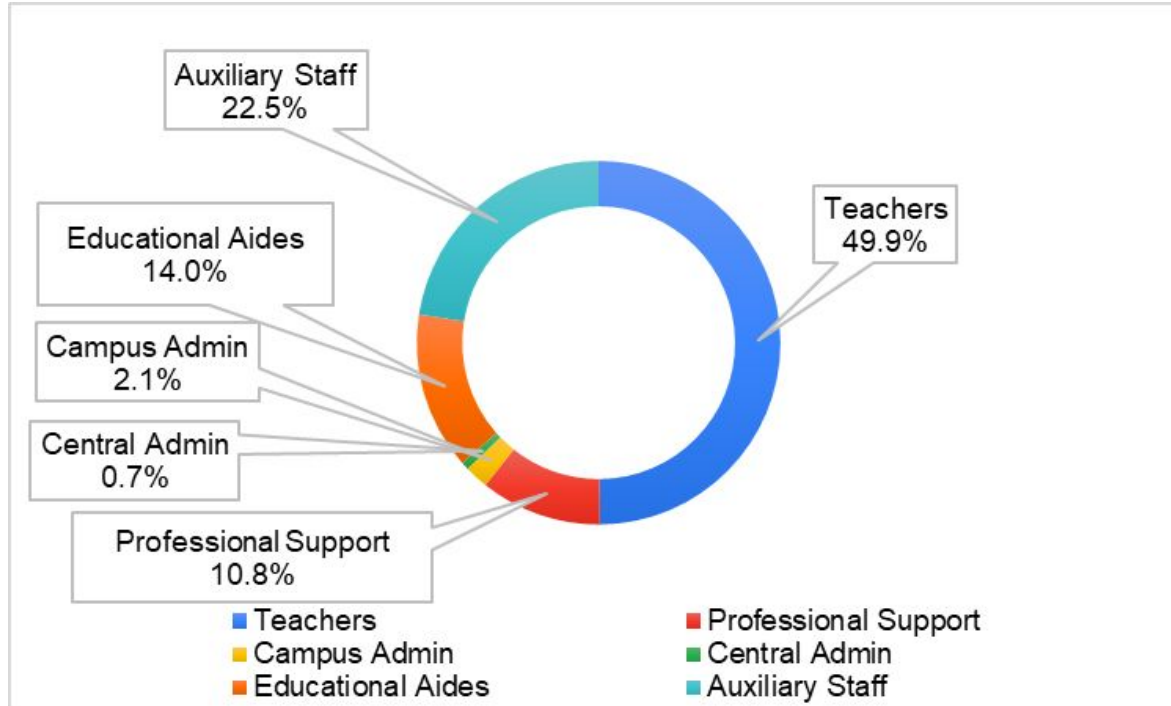

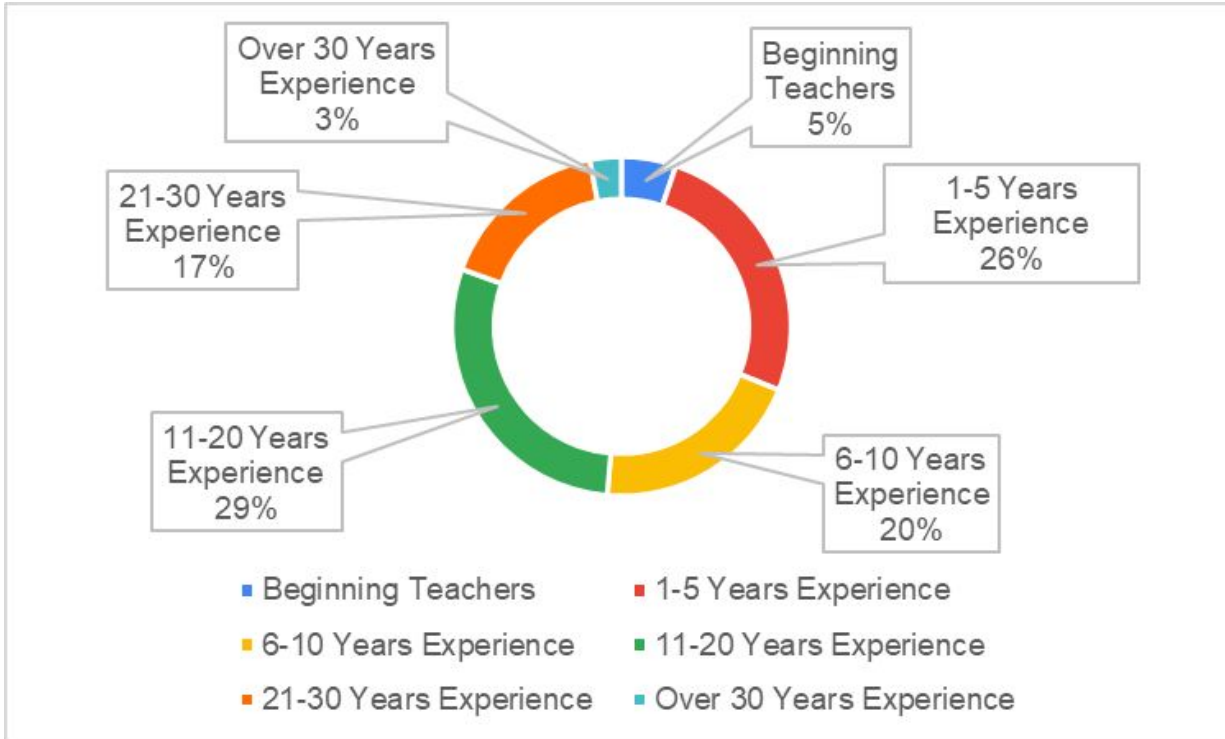
