

NOTICE OF BOND ELECTION FOR COLLEGE STATION INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Board of Trustees of the College Station Independent School District (the "*District*") has ordered a bond election (the "*Election*") as follows:

Section 1. The Election shall be held in the District between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on November 5, 2013 ("*Election Day*"). The Election is to be conducted with, and administered by, Brazos County, Texas (the "*County*"), as provided by Chapter 271 and Chapter 31, Subchapter D of the Texas Election Code (the "*Code*"), and the interlocal agreement between the District and the County (the "*Election Contract*"). Voting for the Election on Election Day and Early Voting shall occur on the dates and during the hours and at the designated polling places as set forth as follows:

Section 2. *Early Voting.* Early voting shall be administered by the County. Early Voting by personal appearance shall begin on October 21, 2013 and conclude on November 1, 2013, and will be conducted at the Early Voting locations on the dates and at the times specified as follows:

Section 3. *Early Voting Clerk.* The address for the Early Voting Clerk is Karen McQueen, Brazos County Clerk, Brazos County Courthouse, 300 E. 26th Street, Suite 120, Bryan, Texas 77803.

Section 4. *Voting by Mail.* Applications for voting by mail for all residents of the District shall be mailed to: Brazos County Clerk, Karen McQueen, County Courthouse 300 E. 26th Street, Suite 120, Bryan, Texas 77803 by October 25, 2013. If application to vote by mail is made by personal delivery, the application must be delivered by close of business on October 18, 2013 to Brazos County Clerk, Karen McQueen, County Courthouse 300 E. 26th Street, Suite 120, Bryan, Texas 77803.

Section 5. *Qualified Voters.* All qualified electors of and residing in the District, shall be entitled to vote at the election.

Section 6. *Proposition.* At the Election the following PROPOSITION shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION

Shall the Board of Trustees of the College Station Independent School District be authorized to issue the bonds of the District, in one or more series, in the aggregate principal amount of \$83,500,000 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing and equipping school facilities within the District, the purchase of necessary sites for school buildings, and the purchase of school buses, with the bonds to mature, bear interest, and be issued and sold in accordance with law at the time of issuance; and shall the Board of Trustees be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes, on all taxable property in the District, sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds and the cost of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?

Section 7. Ballots. The official ballots for the Election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITION with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITION to be expressed substantially as follows:

Section 8. Compliance with Federal Law. In all respects, the Election shall be conducted in accordance with the Code. Pursuant to the federal Help America Vote Act ("*HAVA*") and the Code, at each polling place there shall be at least one voting system that is equipped for disabled individuals, and each such voting system shall be a system that has been certified by the Texas Secretary of State as compliant with *HAVA* and the Code. The District hereby finds that the voting system to be used by the Election Coordinator in administering the Election is such a system, and orders that such voting equipment or other equipment certified by the Texas Secretary of State shall be used by the District in its elections.
